"We are planning to expand its services to other plantations in Malaysia."










SSTCM & SHELL AUDIT


IMS INTERNAL AUDIT

HaowTech Oil & Gas Malaysia Sdn Bhd continues to provide base support services for Bintulu Port Sdn Bhd in 2023.




A simple ceremony was conducted earlier where Encik Lazim Yassin, Head of Operation Bintulu and Encik Adam Jamaludin represented the company.

BEWARE OF KIDDING

How does skidding happen?

Skidding happens when the tires loose grip of the road and the driver loss control of the vehicle causing it to slide sideways or obliquely due to fast driving, slippery road condition, breaking too hard and locking the wheels or turning the wheels sharply.

DO NOT PANIC

What to do if your car is skidding?

- Take your feet off the pedals.
- DO NOT BRAKE
- Hands on the steering wheel. Move the steering to the direction you are going slowly. Do not jerk the steering wheel
- Remain calm

PRECAUTION



Check your tires

• Tires: ensure the treads are at least 2mm in depth and not bald. Bald tires reduce the grip of the road while rain water causes the tires to loose traction.

Check your wipers

 Wipers: check every 6 months to ensure the rubber is in good condition and will help driver's visibility in the rain.



Use the headlights

 Headlights increase your vision in a low light condition and make your vehicle to others

Keep a safe distance

 Keep a safe distance of 70 metre with the vehicle in front of you.
