
Our operations team also assists them with their emergency generator unit's trial run.



Our AFM Fulfillment team was busy with visitors these days. The team welcomed the management team from the well-established salon in Malaysia, Ridzokumura.


Next, the team received visitors from the Customs Department at Kota Damansara to confirm the new relocation address for Altus Freight Management (M) Sdn Bhd.






AES LAUNCHING


NEW SPACE, NEW CHAPTER
