## BASIC OCCUPATIONAL FIRST AID

One of our AOGM colleagues, Qila, participated in Basic Occupational First Aid (BOFA) training in July at the Cert Academy Training Center in Puchong. This program, organised by the Cert Academy complies with government Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH/JKKP) under Guideline on First Aid in the Workplace. The 2-day training course presented BOFA, CPR & AED, and is designed to train average workers or layperson to become a qualified First Aider.



One of the goals of the training is for participants to be able to perform basic life support skills such as CPR and choking, provide first aid management for various injuries including bleeding, burns, shock, fractures, and spinal injuries, understand the systematic approach to survey and diagnose patients as well as the significance of automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to increase survival rates, and become certified first aiders in compliance with the Occupational Safety & Health Act of 1994.

In the event of an emergency situation or workplace disaster, first aid skills will help individuals, coworkers, and employees to assist persons who are hurt. This training is crucial to ensuring the safety of our personnel because our business is one of those that is susceptible to high-risk injuries. It gives staff members the information and abilities they need to handle crises, stop further damage, and minimize casualties.

A comfortable life after retirement is everyone's dream. However, in order to realise that dream, early action must be taken to plan for retirement in order to have sufficient funds to support life after no longer working.

In Malaysia, all companies are required by law to contribute to the employee's EPF account, so if you feel that your money is deducted a lot for the EPF, in fact you are only saving as much as 11% (or 8%) of your salary, and you also get an extra amount of 13% (or 12%) from your employer.

The Employee Provident Fund (EPF) or known as Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) in Malay, is one of the oldest and largest retirement savings funds in the world. Established in 1951, it helps the Malaysian workforce to save to ensure they comply with the Employees' Provident Fund Act 1991.

Although the government has lowered the minimum EPF savings rate to 8% from 11%, you can still choose to contribute at a higher or lower rate. However, before you make such a drastic choice, you need to consider your monthly expenses and also the risk of the change to your family's economy.

# ELEGIO DE LA WITHDRAWAL INITIATIVES

## I-LESTARI

Withdrawal a minimum of RM50 and a maximum of RM500 per month from Account 2 up to a maximum of 12 months.

# I-SAYANG

Allowing the voluntary transfer of two percent EPF contributions from the husband's account to the wife's account.

## I-SINAR

A program for all eligible EPF contributors to withdraw EPF Account 1 savings of 10% with a minimum balance requirement of RM100.

# I-LINDUNG

Retirement fund facility allowing withdrawals from Account 2 to purchase life retirement fund and critical illness insurance.

# I-SARAAN

Aims to encourage those who are self-employed and do not earn a regular income to contribute to the savings scheme within your means voluntarily.
