

▶ Under the Shell FAS project, Altus Bintulu acts as the vessel agent, arranging all vessel activities. Starting off, our team at Kuching Port assisted the inward clearance for the vessel's arrival, which included the arrangement for pilot boat, escort tugboat, and water taxi for the boarding officer. The following activities upon vessel clearance involved arranging crew sign-off and supplying a chemist to conduct gas freeing operations on the supply tugboat.







On the 14th of May 2024, Executive Courage was finally prepared to sail out on her journey from OceanMight Sdn. Bhd. (OMSB) yard in Kuching to Bintulu Port. This marked the start of the McDermott – Shell FAS project. The next day, a kick-off meeting was held with Bintulu authorities and Bintulu Port for offshore transportation and installation from May to November 2024 under the Shell FAS project. The objective of the meeting was to discuss vessel activity for 22 vessels and 1500 manpower involved.

Our operations team, led by Mr. Adam, facilitated and monitored the heavy lifting activities for Executive Courage. This was a 24-hour operation that ran over the course of 2 days.













On the 26th of May 2024, the Altus Bintulu team assisted with the arrival of vessels Executive Courage and Avatar Victory. One of the activities conducted was the heavy lifting of the concrete mattress onto Executive Courage and rearrangement of the concrete matterss balance in the yard.



Additional successful activities conducted under the Berlian McDermott project include the sign-on for DLV 2000 crew, 10 vessel movements back-to-back, and a meeting with authorities and the McDermott team regarding ongoing projects, including the Kasawari and Shell FAS projects. Lastly, there was the successful movement of the F22 substructure from Kuching to Bintulu.

SUPPORTING SSTCM AT BINTULU

▶ Early May, SSTCM HSE team conducted an audit visit to follow-up from the findings of their previous visit back in December 2023. This follow-up is to conduct HSE discussions and exchange of issues, as well as to assist Altus Bintulu in preparing for Petronas iCare visit.

Additionally, Altus Bintulu engaged in the successful delivery of 4 units of tote tank and 2 intermediate bulk containers (IBC) fresh water for Landing Craft (LCT) BIMA 10.





LOGISTICS SUPPORT FOR ENERGY EQUIPMENT TECH (EET)

▶ Upon arriving from Altus Johor, Altus Bintulu supported one of our clients, Energy Equipment Tech (EET) with logistics support for load and backload deck clearance, inward and outward clearance, crew sign-on & sign-off, providing water taxi, and immigration visit to EET vessel.







CHEMICAL HANDLING FOR SSTCM





Altus Labuan has been a dedicated oilfield solutions provider for Sumisaujana TCM Chemicals (SSTCM) Sdn. Bhd.

On the 8th of April 2024, Altus Labuan received two 20-feet Full Container Load (FCL) shipments with chemical contents from SSTCM. These shipments were delivered from the port to Labuan yard, where fellow Altus Labuan personnel carried out safe unstuffing, storage arrangement, and inventory of the products.

Intermediate bulk containers (IBC) were safely placed in a dedicated chemical warehouse for storage before the utilisation and decanting of the products, which will occur on a "first-in, first-out" (FIFO) basis.

THE PREPARATION FOR CEAN DEPARTURE





CEAN, previously known as Ocean Monarch has been under Altus for lay up services since last year. This year during the 2nd quarter, the team at Johor was preparing for her departure to Alang, India.

Altus Johor received a request to supply 10 units of fire extinguishers and various types of medicines during the 2nd day of deballast operations of Rig Cean.



Altus Johor also arranged the formalities of crew change for Rig Cean at Pasir Gudang's immigration office, as well as provided the necessary transportation.





A month later, Altus Johor made the arrangement for the Marine Warranty Surveyor (MWS) to onboard Rig Cean for his monthly report routine, which includes transportation and accommodation. At the same time, the team also organised the supply of provision to Rig Cean.

RIG BOSS 6 TO MMHE SHIPYARD

This quarter, Altus Johor arranged the port passes for UZMA representatives and attended pre-operations meeting for Rig Boss 6, shifting operations from Johor Port wharf to MMHE shipyard.

On top of that, Altus Johor provided services such as lifting of genset and equipment rentals for Rig Boss 6, which was sent via a cargo boat from Johor Port wharf to the rig. This is in line for the preparations prior rig shifting operations to MMHE shipyard.





▶ Altus Johor carried out berthing slot and vessel clearance activities at Johor Container Terminal, Johor Port for TB Melor and GU Melor 1. For 7 GU Melor crews, Altus Johor successfully completed the Special Pass (SP) application at the Pasir Gudang Immigration Office for Pas Lawatan Kerja Sementara (PLKS) document submission to Setia Tropika Immigration.










72 packaged cargos from Technip FMC and Deugro Projects (M) Sdn. Bhd. were loaded onboard barge Infiniti 9. A total of 6 trucks arrived that day for the load out activity. Additionally, 10 crates of cargos were also loaded onboard barge Infiniti 9 for our client, Infiniti Marine. Altus Johor was responsible for the vessel clearance and equipment booking.

In the following month, Altus Johor arranged vessel berthing at Johor Port wharf for Infiniti Marine and Deugro Projects (M) Sdn Bhd, which includes vessel clearance, loading operations for 10 packages, and lashing activity by the ship's crew.

Vessel – Ena Samurai, berthed at Johor Port wharf for inward vessel clearance, loading operation of lashing and rigging equipment, and bunkering of fresh water.

She then shifted to Johor Anchorage for low sulphur marine gas oil (LMSGO) bunkering via ship-to-ship (STS), and boarding officer prior her departure to the next port.

At Port of Tanjung Perlepas (PTP), boarding officers successfully onboarded Tug Bina Marine 35 and Barge Infiniti 3 for her outward clearance to the next port.




KIKEH SHIPMENT -PROJECT MCDERMOTT

Altus Johor arranged the loadout activity for reels arriving from Aker, Klang to Lumut Maritime
Terminal (LMT) open yard for the Kikeh Shipment, a project under McDermott. Altus assisted the inward clearance to Tanjung Langsat wharf for the loadout activity of 3 reels onto Yew Choon Marine 9 that was held the following day with the help of Altus Johor.







ALL ONBOARD BEACON ALTAIR!







Energy Equipment Tech Sdn. Bhd. (EET) delivered 30 boxes of safety equipment and office items to temporary store at our warehouse prior to the Beacon Altair inward clearance and onboard loading. On 30th May 2024, trucking and lifting arrangement was made for the boxes to Johor Port wharf and the boxes were successfully loaded onboard Beacon Altair in preparation for her to sail to Bintulu for its next arrangements.








OILFIELD ACTIVITIES IN TOK BALI




CELEBRATING OUR CORE VALUE – INTEGRITY

Shell Jurong Island has been a steadfast user of the Ex-R2 robotic system for routine inspections. However, recent maintenance needs involving specific Ex components required Altus's expertise.
